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## 9 Powerful Reds from Paso Robles

New reviews of Rhône-style wines from the 2012 and 2013 vintages

If California's Rhône-style reds have been off your radar in recent years, then you've been missing out. The 2012 wines have plenty of generous, rich and plump fruit, with the top wines delivering depth and structure.

The 2012 growing season was one of the easiest California vintners have experienced in many years—a relief, since 2011 was among the most problematic. In 2012, every major growing area found success with red Rhône.

The standout region continues to be Paso Robles, in California's Central Coast, as this week's collection of new releases demonstrates. Just about every red grape from the Rhône Valley is planted there, whether it's Syrah, Grenache, Mourvèdre, Carignane, Counoise or Cinsault.

Winemakers in Paso have a particular knack for mixing those grapes in various combinations to create red blends that are as distinctive as the names they bear. Some, such as Caliza's Sympatico, blend in non-Rhône grapes like Tempranillo for additional spice. At Calcareous, winemaker Jason Joyce blends in a dollop of Petit Verdot (a Bordeaux grape) to add structure and power to the aptly named Moose.

Calcareous, in fact, has an excellent showing this week and leads the pack with the silky Trés Violet, as well as impressive bottlings of Syrah and Grenache.

### **CALCAREOUS Trés Violet Paso Robles 2012 Score: 92 | \$48**

Supple and vibrant, with a focused core wrapped in a silky texture. Aromas of rose petal, raspberry and cigar box lead to layered flavors of blueberry, cracked pepper and smoky cinnamon. Mourvèdre, Grenache and Syrah. Drink now through 2023. 870 cases made.—*T.F.*

### **CALCAREOUS Grenache Paso Robles 2012 Score: 91 | \$40**

A rich and racy red, with bold aromas of smoky raspberry and lusciously layered flavors of black cherry, cinnamon and spiced toffee. Drink now through 2021. 370 cases made.—*T.F.*

Dense and quietly potent, with spicy red and black fruit accents and layered flavors that show smoky cracked pepper, mineral and grilled herb nuances. Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre. Drink now through 2022. 130 cases made.—*T.F.*

**TABLAS CREEK Côtes de Tablas Paso Robles 2013 Score: 90 | \$35**

Supple and balanced, with pretty wild flower and raspberry aromas and sleek flavors of smoky red plum, herbes de Provence and loamy mineral. Grenache, Syrah, Counoise and Mourvèdre. Drink now through 2020. 1,580 cases made.—*T.F.*

**TABLAS CREEK Esprit de Tablas Paso Robles 2012 Score: 90 | \$55**

Graceful and delicately complex, with a lively core of bright acidity that plays up a floral boysenberry aroma. Offers sleek flavors of raspberry, smoked spice and subtle bitter chocolate. Mourvèdre, Syrah, Grenache and Counoise. Drink now through 2021. 4,400 cases made.—*T.F.*

**EBERLE Côtes-du-Rôbles Paso Robles 2012 Score: 87 | \$23**

Appealing, with smoky plum aromas and briary flavors of cherry, tobacco and spice. Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre, Durif. Drink now through 2019. 566 cases made.—*T.F.*
